Entry Requirements for all our degree programmes:

Full time/normal entry: MSCE/GCSE/Ordinary Level/Equivalent Full Certificate with six credits including English and Mathematics (a maximum of 30 points)/Upper Level Passes or A-Level/IB One A-Level/Upper-Level Pass.

Mature entry: MSCE/GCSE/Ordinary Level/Equivalent Full Certificate with six credits including English and Mathematics/Upper Level Passes or A-Level/IB One A-Level/Upper-Level Pass, Diploma in Business or Related Qualifications PLUS a minimum of 2 years' experience.

Application forms and other details - Application forms can be collected from our campuses in Blantyre, Lilongwe or Mzuzu, or downloaded from our website, www.mca.ac.mw.

Closing date for applications is Wednesday 30th March, 2018

CERTIFICATE IN FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

This is a **15-Week** course, which comprises the following modules:

- 1. Interpretation of Financial Statements (IFS)**
- 2. Budgeting and Budgetary Control (BBC)**
- 3. Financial Management (FM)**
- 4. Ethics and Governance (EG)**

Duration and mode of attendance - The course will run over a period of 15 weeks, from mid-April to July, 2018, with the examinations taking place during week 16. Attendance will be evening classes, one day a week, from 17:00 to 21:00hrs, and the course will be available at all our campuses in Blantyre, Lilongwe and Mzuzu. Candidates who successfully completes the course and pass the examinations will be awarded a certificate in financial management.

Tuition fees for this programmes is MWK320, 000

Target group - Senior executives, managers, supervisors and elected office bearers with a non-finance background wishing to equip themselves with an understanding of financial management, interpreting financial statements, the process of budgeting and budgetary control and corporate risk, ethics and governance issues.
