Entry Requirements and Mode of Application

a) Generic Entry (Year 1)

Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE), or any O-level equivalent certificate with six credits, including English and Mathematics.

b) Mature Entry (Years 2 and 3)

Applicants must have a Malawi School of Education (MSCE) with at least four credits, PLUS a diploma in a relevant field.

Tuition fees: MWK 950,000 per semester

The Master's in Business Administration is tailored for aspiring and current business executives who are committed to enhancing their management skills, strategic thinking, and leadership capabilities, and is offered by the School of Postgraduate Studies under the **Block release** mode of delivery.

Tuition fees: MWK2,100,000 per semester

Entry Requirements and Mode of Application

Applicants must have a bachelor's degree/Professional qualification or its equivalent from an accredited institution/professional body, coupled with a minimum of 2 (Two) years of work experience.

Application procedure: After completing the application form, applicants must deposit a non-refundable application fee of MWK30,000.00 into the following bank account:
