## **Introduction of ODeL - May, 2022!**

**Introduction of ODeL** - Malawi College of Accountancy is pleased to announce the introduction of ODeL (Open Distance electronic Learning) for the following degree programmes:

1. Bachelor of Applied Accounting, Auditing & Information Systems
2. Bachelor of Business Management & Entrepreneurship

The College has adopted a unique approach to ODeL, which combines self-study materials (developed by subject experts with many years of experience in delivering face-to-face classes), online and special face-to-face sessions.

**Accessing study materials** - Upon registration and payment of fees, students will be provided with credentials to access the learning materials from the ODeL portal. Those without access to reliable internet can opt for their materials to be emailed, or sent to them in a flash disk, or in exceptional cases, in booklet form. Our goal is to ensure that anyone wishing to study with us is accommodated, without being restricted by technology or location.

**Tutor support** - ODeL students will have access to quality tutor support throughout their studies. They will also have an opportunity to attend special support sessions before both mid-semester and end-semester exams.

**Enrolment criteria and assessments** - ODeL students will be enrolled based on the same entry criteria as the other students. They will be supported by lecturers who also lecture face-to-face classes, and will write the same assignments and exams. This means that there will be no

difference in the nature and quality of the qualification from the current ones.

**Invitation for applications** - The College is inviting applications for enrolment to the following degree programmes to be delivered through ODeL:

- Bachelor of Applied Accounting, Auditing & Information Systems
- Bachelor of Business Management & Entrepreneurship

Students can apply to be admitted into years 1, 2 or 3 depending on their qualifications and experience.

### **Fee Structure:**

ODeL fees are as follows: Year 1 – K300,000/semester; Year 2 – K350,000/semester; Year 3– K400,000/semester.

### **Entry Requirements**

#### **Full time/normal entry (Year 1)**

MSCE/GCSE/Ordinary Level/Equivalent Full Certificate with six credits, including English.

#### **Mature entry (Years 2 & 3)**

Full MSCE with at least 4 credits, Diploma in the relevant field PLUS a minimum of 2 years work experience.

**Closing date for applications:** 30<sup>th</sup> April 2022
